## —SAFETY TIPS—

### How **Dangerous** is Fentanyl?

**50x**

Stronger than **Heroin**

**100x**

Stronger than **Morphine**

The amount of fentanyl it takes to overdose and die is equivalent to **2 GRAINS OF SAND**.

### Signs of **Overdose**:

- Small constricted “pinpoint pupils”
- Falling asleep/losing consciousness
- Slow, weak or no breath
- Choking and gurgling sounds
- Limp Body
- Cold or clammy skin
- Discolored skin (blue/grey)
- Vomiting
- Slurred or loss of speech

### Save A **Life**:

- 1** Call 911 Immediately
- 2** Administer Naloxone, if available
- 3** Keep person breathing and awake
- 4** Lay person on their side to prevent choking
- 5** Stay until paramedic assistance arrives
